This book examines Howe's diary entries in the thematic context of the local Costumbrista literary production. Costumbrismo both documented local customs and critically analyzed social ills. In his letters to relatives and friends Howe depicted a more personal reaction to the underpinnings of slavery practices, a reaction reflecting early abolitionist sentiments.

Pensamos que este es el objeto principal de Wojtyła: una verdadera fundamentación de la ética que da sustento y base a la norma personalista. Finalmente, estudiamos la originalidad de abordar la antropología (y la ética) desde la dimensión donal del ser personal. Para ello, abordamos el don desde las inspiraciones de Ferrer, de Jean Luc Marion, Bruaire y otros. Pensamos que es una de las contribuciones más importantes a la ética y antropología filosófica hechas por varios filósofos de los últimos siglos: la dimensión del don y de la autodonación de la persona en el amor.
