John Selby became a noted author of psychology, self-help and philosophy books, and Paul Jeffrey Davids became an accomplished film director (among whose many films is Timothy Leary's Dead, an authorized biography of the Harvard psychology professor and LSD 'guru' filmed the last year of Leary's life.) Those who have read and value books such as A Beautiful Mind, One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest, Lisa and David, The Electric Kool-Aid Acid Test, The Magus and I Never Promised You a Rose Garden will find these authors to be kindred spirit.
